- Several quality-of-life improvements, additions, and modifications onto an existing platform: accessibility improvements on an automation user interface with which to query Elasticsearch data; extension of a Python task queue application with MariaDB database trigger for user creation; migration of an internal logging system from local, poorly-rotated log files onto Elasticsearch; GNU/Linux update processes such as moving Ubuntu 18.04 servers onto 20.04 and later 22.04; and that's just to name a few.
